Press Release

On the 16th August the British Red Cross Mobility Aids Service in Cambridge closed down. This has been replaced by a wheelchair only hire service available on line from a national centre.

The service in Cambridge operated for many years in the local community and was a popular and respected with referrals coming from Addenbrookes, local GPs and regular users.

The volunteers at Cambridge who operated this service provided a wide range of equipment in addition to wheelchairs such as toilet items, rollators, walking frames, crutches and other aids for a small charge or donation to the service.

The volunteers are very concerned about the impact of the closure of the Mobility Aids Service on the local community which many people found both essential and necessary. Customers were dismayed and asked where they could now source the equipment without having to purchase new items as more often than not their need is short term.

We are very keen to continue offering the wider service to the community and are proposing to set up a 'not for profit' community service, CB Mobility Support, which will provide mobility aids other than the wheelchair hire.

Shelford Rugby Club, through Rory Finlayson, has kindly offered us a home at the Club's premises and a storage container has been donated to us by the City Council. We still have several things to organise but hope to open later in October. However as with all these projects costs are involved so we are actively seeking financial help of any sort and for those that can help we will be very pleased to advertise their support .
